



AX-S Tank Bag Mounting Instructions

Step 1.) Remove the front strap and study your bike for available mounting points.



Step 2.) Route the adjustable strap around the steering tube and under the front fairing stay. Be sure to keep straps away from lines and wires.



Step 3.) Route the strap through its looped end so the strap encircles the mounting point.



Step 4.) Adjust the front strap to desired length, attached bag with the plastic clip, and remove the two rear straps from the plastic adjusters. Remove protective sheaths.



Step 5.) I have located a good mounting point on this particular model along the sub-frame that is close to the fuel tank and away from direct contact of heat generating parts



Step 6.) Route the strap through its looped end so the strap encircles the mounting point.



Step 7.) Pull the protective sheath over the strap for further protection of painted surfaces.



Step 8.) Run the strap through the friction adjuster attached to the bag and back through the second friction adjuster on the strap.



Step 9.) Use the elastic loop to help manage any extra strap length after proper adjustment is achieved. Do not leave any straps hang freely.



Step 10.) Pull the protective sheath up so it helps protect your fuel tank.



Step 11.) Repeat steps 5-10 for the other side of the bag and make sure the bag sits securely on the centerline of the tank.



Step 12.) Ride safe and have fun!
